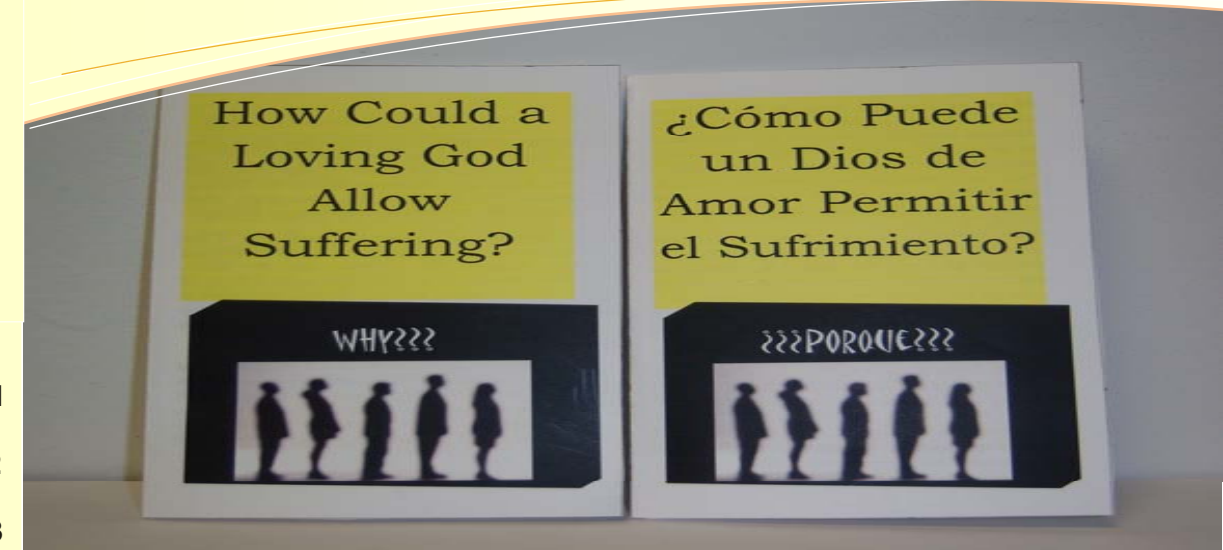

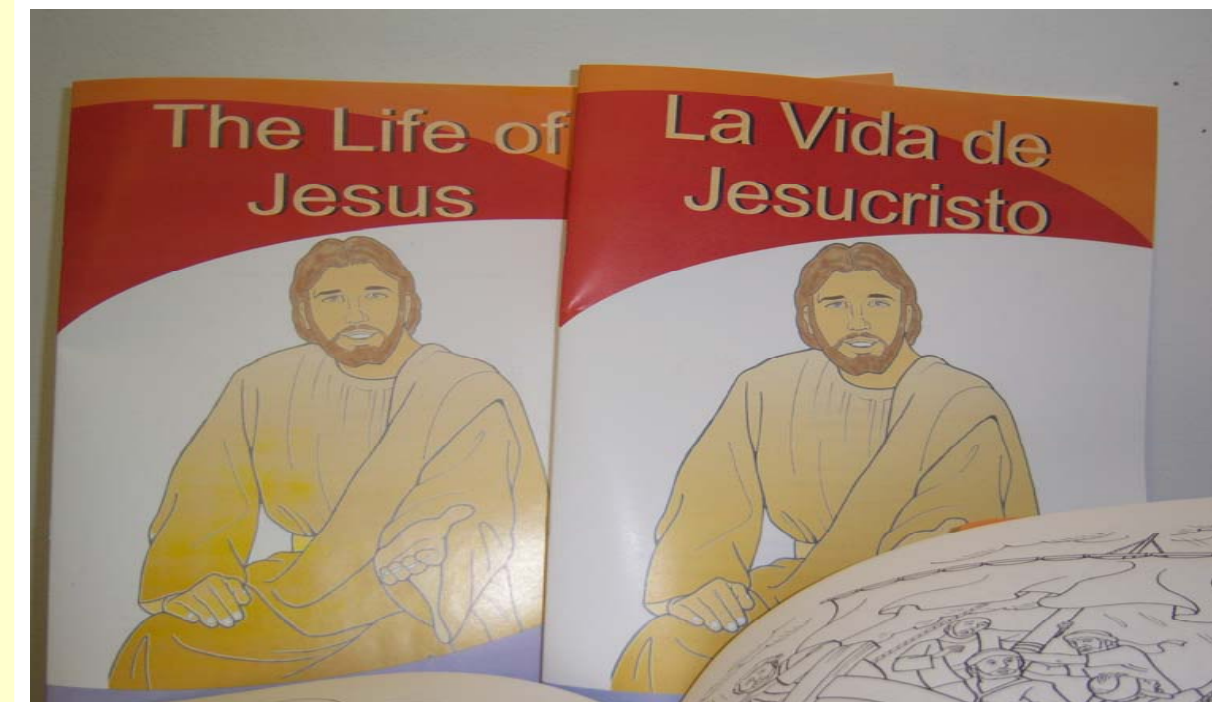


From the Staff at S.A.E.M. **INTRODUCING OUR NEWEST GOSPEL LITERATURE**

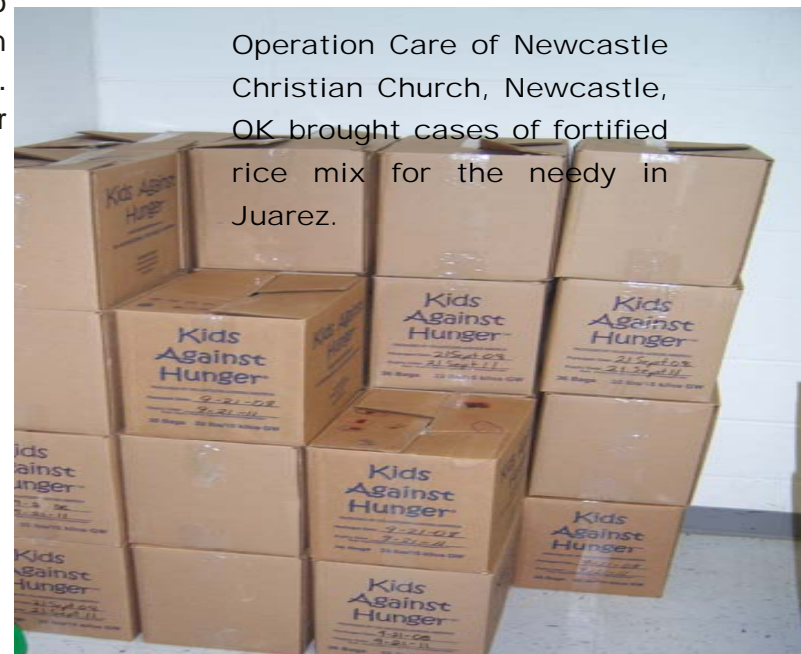
On Saturday he brings New testaments and tracts, along with coffee, juice, milk and sweet bread to share with the people at hospitals, showing patients and visitors that God cares.

Blanca Lidia Meza and other women assisted by Blanca's husband Marco Meza, a retired Juarez police officer, have a jail ministry in Mexico. Their son, also a police officer, is trying to stand for truth and righteousness in the midst of rampant police corruption.

Blanca and Marco came in for a coffee pot, 3200 tracts and forty New Testaments to take to the prisoners. Their hope and their motivation is the prisoners' salvation.

Marco once served Juarez as a minister of justice according to Romans 13. Now he and his wife serve the Lord as evangelists of the gospel to the least of these in Juarez.

Pray that God brings forth fruit and the increase of souls in the kingdom of God through courageous couples like Marco and Blanca.
